



2014 MARSTON FAMILY VINEYARD ALBION



Our sixth vintage of Albion continues in the traditional Bordeaux Blanc style with rich, concentrated fruit balanced by an elegant backbone of acidity and personality. Named for our forefather, *Albion Marston*, this special release combines classic Old World structure with New World fruit, embracing our heritage from the chalk cliffs of Dover to the Pacific Coast of Northern California, declared “New Albion” by Sir Francis Drake.

Appellation: Yountville, Napa Valley

Composition: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

Harvest Date: August 29th and September 5th, 2014.

Vinification: 65% French Oak, 35% Stainless

Production: 275 Cases bottled on May 4th, 2015

Winemaker Tasting Notes: *“A perfumed bouquet of white flowers with notes of lemon, green apple, pear, passion fruit, orange zest, melon, and mineral. A white nectarine front leads to a juicy mouth of guava, mango, passion fruit, and lime. The finish is long and clean with flavors tangerines and Asian pear.”* ~ Marbue Marke
